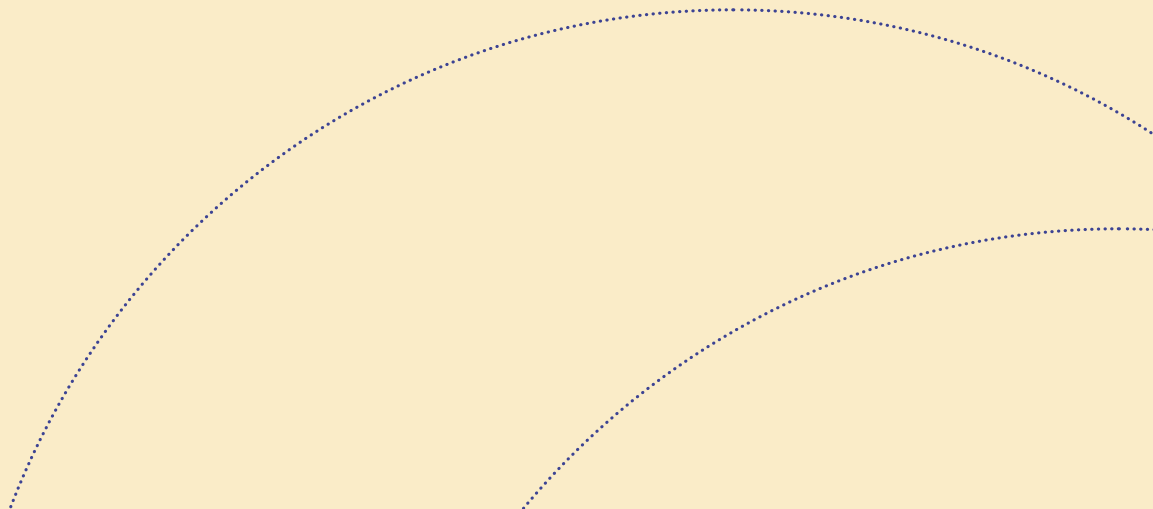

Integrates the Work Plan 2023-2025 of the INTOSAI Working Group on Environmental Auditing (INTOSAI WGEA)



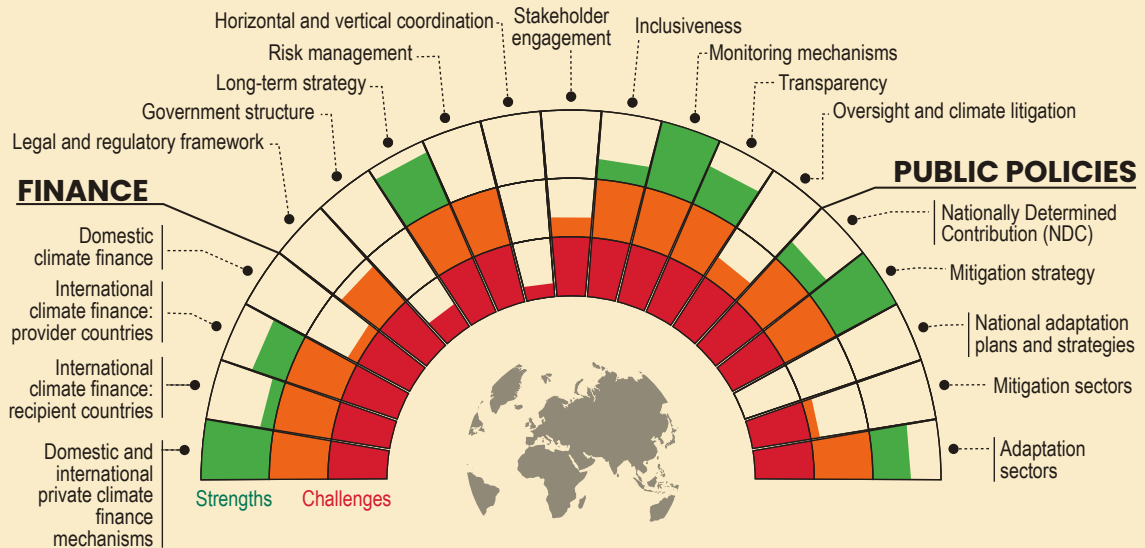

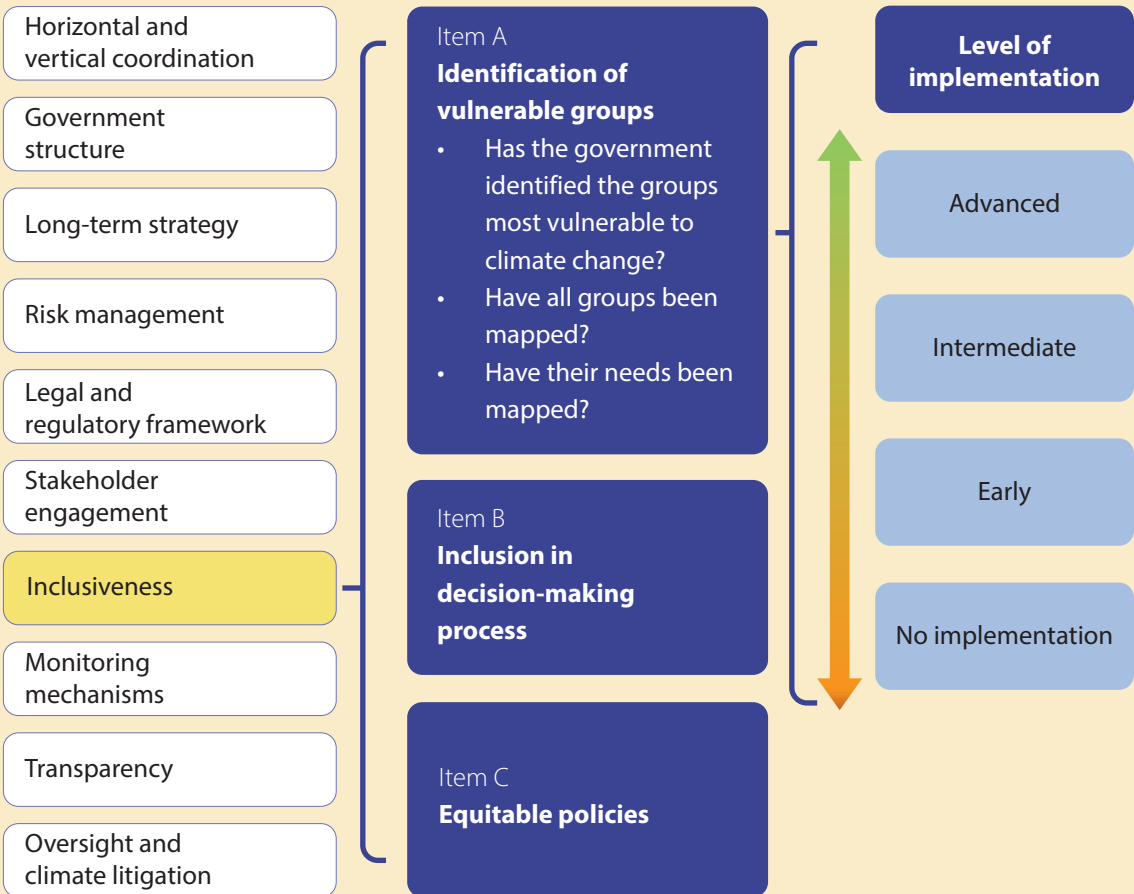

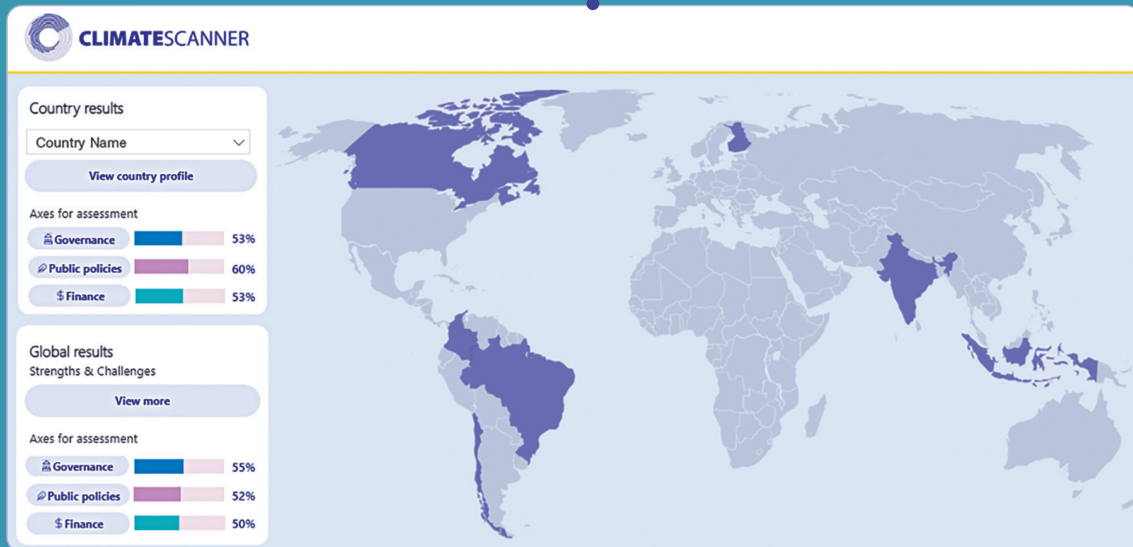
